The Cal-HOSA Board of Directors is pleased to continue the recognition program “Cal-HOSA Honor Roll” intended for HOSA members achieving high academics.

The Cal-HOSA Honor Roll is designed to recognize those members of Cal-HOSA who excel in academic preparation for a career in the healthcare industry. Cal-HOSA recognizes that in order to succeed as a health careers professional, members need to be well prepared in terms of their academics, career skills, personal, and leadership development. HOSA members must get a score of 70% or higher to be recognized.

Cal-HOSA members are encouraged to apply for this highly esteemed recognition. Applicants who meet the following criteria will be placed on the Cal-HOSA Honor Roll and will be recognized at the State Leadership Conference.

All of the following criteria MUST be met to be considered for recognition. Incomplete applications will be disqualified and not judged.

- Completed application form (attached).
- Verification of a cumulative GPA of at least 3.7 on a 4.0 scale by transcript from school registrar (*Does not need to be an official transcript if you have to pay for this service*).
- Resume’ describing HOSA leadership ability through service as a chapter officer, committee leader, participation in chapter activities, or other school, community service, volunteer service, or employment.
- A one-page statement outlining: (a) career objectives, (b) plans to achieve these career objectives, and (c) how Cal-HOSA contributed to successful completion of these plans. Statement must be typed, double spaced, not greater than 12 pt. font, and in MLA format.

Complete the application form and submit with all supporting documents to Cal-HOSA Headquarters by **February 27, 2012**.
